HOW TO PLAY:

The rules for Tapeface are simple.

Two teams of around 5 players are each furnished with a roll or two of Sellotape or surgical tape.

The aim of the game is for the teams to most drastically alter their appearances with the least evidence of tape or surgery in a pre-agreed period of time.

The ladies of the WC recommend running each round of the game to the length of Madonna's 'Celebrate'. The word "celebrate" can be substituted for the word "Sellotape" for added enjoyment (for full lyrics please Gideogram Mr Reeling). You are welcome of course to do this even if you choose to use surgical tape.

One person may remain impartial to act as the judge - perhaps your guest of honour or whoever is left over, or funniest. Or you can play non-competitively just for larks.

That's the whole game. Teams may remain with their new faces for as long as they can be bothered or are still entertained.
